Operations Report

Chief Metcalfe and Assistant Chief Boehl

1. Discussion regarding the proposal for turnout gear. It is recommended to proceed with **MES Life Safety** and purchase **Morning Pride** fire gear for a cost not to exceed \$67,000 - **APPROVED**.
 2. Part-Time Automotive Mechanic, past BC Kevin Quinlan started in his new role today working with Fire Mechanic Bell. The Chiefs met with the both of them this morning to discuss expectations, workflows and processes. They were already able to accomplish a few tasks this morning while working together on West Webster and Webster Fire's Fleet.
 3. Surplus - Lt. Mastin has put forth a Surplus Request for two pieces of EMS Equipment that are no longer necessary for the Irondequoit Fire District. The items for surplus are: (2) Cardiac Science Powerheart G5 AED's - **APPROVED**.
 4. First Arriving (Website) - The draft version of our website is available. Everything is shaping up, with a few modifications needed that Captain Serenati is aware of, but we are nearing completion.
 5. First Due - We have received the quote from First Due for scheduling. As we have discussed previously, all elements of our operation are now under First Due with the exception of Training (Fire Engineering) and scheduling (CrewSense). We would like to move forward with First Due, the quote is for the remainder of 2025 and all of 2026 which is almost a 50% saving compared to CrewSense at a cost of \$4,800. As noted before, CrewSense is failing massively and is impacting our payroll operations - **APPROVED**.
 6. Congratulations to several of our new Volunteer Firefighters who are graduating from the Monroe County Firefighter 1 program this evening: Firefighter Ryan Russo, Firefighter Angelo Russo and Firefighter Ivan Zhekalo. Well done!
 7. Metal work for the memorial library has been mounted, and albeit some changes to the backlighting and decoration of the walls with memorabilia and historical pieces, the room is nearing completion. Thank you again for the support of the project, it is an excellent memorial to remember the historical LODD's of our past agencies.
 8. Thank you to all the groups at the Culver Station who have assisted with cleaning/painting the stucco on the front of firehouse in advance of the new sign installation next week.
- Captain Kohlmeier, Lieutenants Holahan and Nicosia began the First Line Supervisor Training Program (FLSTPs) program this morning at FDNY. They will be there over the next two weeks and then will return to duty around 12/15/25. Any IT concerns in the meantime can be directed to Chief Metcalfe.
