RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF SPECIAL OPERATIONS UNIT (SOU) VEHICLE

(Subject to Permissive Referendum)

At a regular meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Irondequoit Fire District, Monroe County, New York, held on **April 6, 2026**, the following resolution was offered and adopted:

WHEREAS,

the Irondequoit Fire District has established a Capital Apparatus and Equipment Reserve Fund pursuant to §6-g of the General Municipal Law; and

WHEREAS,

the Board of Fire Commissioners has determined that it is necessary and in the best interest of the District to acquire a **Special Operations Unit (SOU) vehicle** to support emergency response, technical rescue, and specialized operational functions; and

WHEREAS,

said apparatus will consist of a **2026 Ford F-550 Crew Cab 4x4 chassis with a custom aluminum utility body, emergency lighting and warning systems, onboard power systems, and specialized storage and operational equipment**; and

WHEREAS,

such acquisition is consistent with the District's **long-range Capital Plan and apparatus replacement strategy**; and

WHEREAS,

the total cost of said apparatus, including vehicle, body, equipment, installation, and all associated costs, is estimated not to exceed **\$150,000**; and

WHEREAS,

the purchase of such apparatus is a purpose for which the Capital Apparatus and Equipment Reserve Fund was established;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Board of Fire Commissioners hereby authorizes the expenditure of a sum **not to exceed \$150,000** from the Capital Apparatus and Equipment Reserve Fund for the purchase, construction, and outfitting of a Special Operations Unit (SOU) apparatus.
2. The Board is hereby authorized to enter into contracts and take all actions necessary to effectuate the purchase and outfitting of said apparatus.
3. This Resolution is adopted **subject to permissive referendum** in accordance with §6-g of the General Municipal Law.
4. This Resolution shall take effect **thirty (30) days after its adoption**, unless a petition is filed in accordance with law requiring a referendum.
